Vocabulary Words: Hand-building, slabs, coil, slip, score, fire, compression

Objective: Visitors will apply the knowledge of the Weihnachtspyramide to the construction of a slab clock.

Materials: Clay, slip, examples of candle

Tools: Sponge, modeling stick, scoring tool, cookie cutters, newspaper, rolling pin, slats,

canvas, cylinder, needle tool

Historical/Cultural Background: Docent Tour

Steps:

Slabs

- 1. Using a rolling pin, roll out a large slab, measure and cut to fit around the cylinder.
- 2. Once the cuts are made, smooth the cuts with the modeling stick and sponge.

Cut Outs

1. Select a cookie cutter for your cutout shape. Make sure it's right in the middle of your vase.

Cylinder

- I. Slip and score the edges.
- 2. Wrap the cylinder with newspaper, wrap the clay slab around it and seal and smooth the joints.
- 3. Remove the pipe, then the newspaper, and seal the inside joint with the modeling stick.
- 4. Measure the circular slab for the base and cut to fit.
- 5. Slip and score the bottom of the cylinder and the edge of the circular slab, then join.

Finishing:

1. Make another cylinder to go on the inside or outside of your candle.
