WHAT IS A THEME IN ART?

Themes in art are often message about life, society or human nature and are usually implied rather than explicitly stated.

A Theme is not the same as the subject of a work. For example, The subject of the movie Star Wars, Empire Strikes Back is a battle between the Galactic Empire and the Rebel Alliance, whereas the themes might be moral ambiguity or the conflict between technology and nature.
